Rich Marquez is the Colorado Director for Justice Programs with the Latino Coalition for Community Leadership (LCCL). In this capacity Rich is engaged in the organizational development of community and faith-based organizations whose missions support the delivery of restorative services to individuals with the lived experience of incarceration. Prior to joining the LCCL, Rich was a team member of the Primary Care Office at the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment whose work supports the access to care needs for medically vulnerable individuals and communities.
