Kathy Irene Kennedy, DrPH, MA, AB, is the Director of the Regional Institute for Health and Environmental Leadership (RIHEL). RIHEL is the CDC-founded regional public health leadership development institute for Colorado, Wyoming and New Mexico. RIHEL provides leadership training and other professional development experiences in the region for the public health and environmental health workforce, and for other health and environment professionals. With nearly 1000 graduates of its flagship Advanced Leadership Training Program and other comprehensive leadership development programs, RIHEL is also an association of vibrant, forward-looking professionals dedicated to the health and environment of the region. RIHEL is a model of inter-sector collaboration for professionals in the public and private sectors and in the health and environment fields. Dr. Kennedy is Professor of Public Health at the University of Colorado's Colorado School of Public Health where she directs the master of public health degree program in maternal and child health and two public health certificate programs. Dr. Kennedy is a member of the Board of Directors of the Colorado Foundation for Public Health and the Environment, which she led as president from 2010-2012. She is a member of the Community Advisory Committee of the Center for Public Health Practice at the Colorado School of Public Health.
